- The leading cause of injury to woman between the ages of 15 and 44 in the USA is domestic violence
- ➤ At least 25% of all women will experience domestic violence
- ➤ It is estimated that 75% of domestic violence cases go unreported

- On average 4 children a day lose their lives to child abuse in the USA
- >80% of those are under four years old
- > 46% of homeless runaways ran away to escape abuse
- Over 6 million children witness domestic violence every year

- >30% of abuse children go on to abuse their own children
- Boys who witnessed domestic violence are twice as likely to abuse their own partners and or children
