

The Secret to Love that Lasts

Words of Affirmation

The person whose primary love language is Words of Affirmation would really feel loved when you express your appreciation for the things that person does or what that person means to you.

Quality Time

To express love to a person whose primary love language is Quality Time, you would spend time doing things with them. This could be going to a ballgame, a dinner, or doing some other things that that person enjoys.

Receiving Gifts

Someone whose love language is Receiving Gifts might feel loved when you get them some flowers or something else they like – even giving of your time.

Physical Touch

Holding hands, hugging, kissing, even give a few pats on the back – these are ways of expressing love to someone whose love language is physical touch.
