Proverbs 1:1-2 (NLT) These are the proverbs of Solomon, David's son, king of Israel.

² Their purpose is to teach people wisdom and discipline, to help them understand the insights of the wise. Prov 1:7 (NLT) Fear of the Lord is the foundation of true knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and discipline.
