John 11:1-15 (NLT)

A man named Lazarus was sick. He lived in Bethany with his sisters, Mary and Martha.



² This is the Mary who later poured the expensive perfume on the Lord's feet and wiped them with her hair. Her brother, Lazarus, was sick.

³ So the two sisters sent a message to Jesus telling Him, "Lord, your dear friend is very sick."

4 But when Jesus heard about it He said, "Lazarus's sickness will not end in death. No, it happened for the glory of God so that the Son of God will receive glory from this."

⁵ So although Jesus loved Martha, Mary, and Lazarus, ⁶ He stayed where He was for the next two days.

but Jesus meant
Lazarus had died.**

14 So He told them plainly, "Lazarus is dead. 15 And for your sakes, I'm glad I wasn't there, for now you will really believe. Come, let's go see him."

³ “It was not because of his sins or his parents’ sins,” Jesus answered. “This happened so the power of God could be seen in him.




⁴ We must quickly carry out the tasks assigned us by the One who sent us. The night is coming, and then no one can work.

45 Many of the people who were with Mary believed in Jesus when they saw this happen.

**46 But some went to the
Pharisees and told
them what Jesus had
done.**

47 Then the leading priests and Pharisees called the high council together. "What are we going to do?" they asked each other. "This Man certainly performs many miraculous signs.



48 If we allow Him to go on like this, soon everyone will believe in Him. Then the Roman army will come and destroy both our Temple and our nation.”

They said what Jesus had
told them to say, and they
were permitted to take it.**

**Then they brought the
colt to Jesus and threw
their garments over it,
and He sat on it.**

Many in the crowd had seen Jesus call Lazarus from the tomb, raising him from the dead, and they were telling others about it.
